Ruby

- Minor revisions released
 - 2.5.1
 - 2.4.4
 - 2.3.7
 - 2.2.10
 - Mostly security fixes and bug fixes
 - String unpack has a buffer issue with large numbers and user input
 - mktmpdir has directory traversal issue with user input
 - Webrick issues: dos/http response splitting
 - Upgrade to latest minor version

Hanami

- v1.2.0rc2 released
 - Colored logging
 - Non restful routes can be generated
 - Bugfixes
 - Stable release scheduled for April

Rails

- Rails 5.1.6, 5.0.7 released
 - 5.0.7
 - Loofah fix, dir.mktmpdir for cache dir, pg sequence collision fixes
 - Since Sep 2017
 - 5.1.6
 - Loofah fix, compare ruby version correct way
 - Since feb 2018
- Rails 5.2.0 released
 - http/2 early hints
 - Credentials (encrypted secrets you can check in)
 - Redis cache store
 - File upload (active storage)
 - CSP
 - http://edgeguides.rubyonrails.org/5_2_release_notes.html
 - Webpacker 3
