

# What's Happening: Ruby In The Last Few Months

# Ruby

- 2.6.0-preview1 released
  - JIT (emits C, compiles it)
  - Visual Studio support planned
- Ruby Gems has more security holes
  - Upgrade to version 2.7.6 of Ruby gems or patch your ruby

# Hanami

- v1.1.1 released
  - Support for ruby 2.5+
  - bugfixes
- v1.2.0beta1 released
  - http/2 early hints (more <https://tools.ietf.org/html/draft-ietf-httpbis-early-hints-05> )
  - New js lib
  - CLI callbacks

# Rails

- Rails 5.1.5 released
  - Bugfixes, :pluck perf fix
- Rails 5.2.0 rc1 released
  - http/2 early hints
  - Credentials (encrypted secrets you can check in)
  - Redis cache store

# What Google Finds Popular
